






What is PDMP and its Purpose?

- Improve controlled substance prescribing
- Inform clinical practice
- Reduce the number of people who misuse, abuse, or overdose

PDMP Participation Process


- To participate, jurisdictions must:
 - Enact legislation authorizing participation in the St. Louis County PDMP
 - Sign the User Agreement with St. Louis County
- Upon enacting legislation & signing the User Agreement, St. Louis County will onboard the jurisdiction in the next possible implementation cycle.
 - Process typically takes ~3 months from enacting legislation to going live with the PDMP.




Who Can Complete PDMP Registration?

- 3 types of Authorized Users
 - 1. Direct, full access for medical and pharmaceutical care Providers, Dispensers, Delegates
 - 2. Ability to request data, no direct access Patients, self-requests
 - 3. Restricted or limited access


PDMP Registration & Utilization by Quarter



Patient Search

- Minimum Search Criteria
 - Patient First Name
 - Patient Last Name
 - Patient Date of Birth
- Additional Optional Criteria
- Search Period
 - Default: previous 12 months
 - Can be shortened or extended
 - up to previous 24 months





Patient Report

- Patient Information
- Multiple Provider Alert (if applicable
 - Generated when a patient obtains controlled substance prescriptions written by 3 or more prescribers <u>and</u> filled at 3 or more pharmacies within a 6 month period.
- Report Summary
- Prescription Information
- Prescriber Information
- Dispenser Information
